This system is, the AARC-EVAC emergency alert system, it is designed to be affordable, particularly when being retrofitted to existing sites. Its system’s emergency push buttons are labeled with instantly recognizable icons, not language based text labels.

The AARC-EVAC system’s other important design features, are listed as follows:

- *The system is a wireless radio controlled system, that uses an internationally available radio frequency. No Radio Licences required!*
- *The system is designed to be totally autonomous, where in an emergency, it does not relying on any mains power, or any IT or telecommunications systems.*
- *Each push button alert transmitter is battery operated.*
- *Each receiver-siren and voice instruction broadcast unit, has its own UPS power back-up supply.*
- *The system comes with indoor and outdoor units and these outdoor unit are also available in solar powered units.*
- *Every system has its own unique radio coding so that no other system can interfere with it.*
- *The system can be triggered by fixed location, push button transmitters or by interfacing to a fire a panel or a range of other fixed sensors/detectors.*
- *Each system has the option of including high intensity flashing LED beacons, with colours to match the alarm type.*
- *Equipment its self is affordable plus cost effective to install, designed to be flexible, suiting sites from the very large to the very small.*

The first step is to carry out a risk assessment:

****** If needed, your company or organization should consider engaging a Safety and/or a Security/Risk Consultant to provide assistance in this process.

Step 1: Identifying the internal and external threats.

Identify the potential threats that could cause harm to anyone on site or that may come on to your site, this might include employees, clients, customers, visitors etc.

Step 2: Assess Risks

Assess the risks to understand the nature of the harm, that the threats could cause and the likelihood and seriousness of the harm.

Step 3: Controlling or Reducing the Risks

All risks will need to be prioritized based on the seriousness of the harm and of the highest risks. Then assess what can be done to assist to help to avert or minimize the impact of these threatening events.

Averting or Reducing the impact of internal and external threats, based on the outcomes of your risk assessment?

Voice notifications can substantially improve the effectiveness of any emergency assist-alert system, when compared to a siren alone, or no system at all. Such a system provides a high potential for delivering better outcomes.

Note: The AARC-EVAC system can deliver both Assist and Alert notifications, all in one system, based on your needs.

In addition the AARC-EVAC can also add voice notification to your current siren only Evacuation system, all within the same system.
